- 1962: Born Nov 4. Father is top Congolese businessman
- 1992: Personal assistant to late dictator *Mobutu Sese Seko*
- 1998: Heads Ugandan-backed Congolese Liberation Movement (MLC) following overthrow of Mobutu
 - 2002: Helps then President Ange-Felix Patasse of Central African
- Republic to resist coup attempt

 2003: Sworn in as vice-president of Congo after MLC signs peace deal
- with President *Joseph Kabila*2006: Loses run-off to Kabila in first democratic elections in 40 years
- 2007: Flees to Belgium after his militia defy government order to disarm and heavy fighting breaks out in Kinshasa
- 2008: Arrested in Brussels on International Criminal Court warrant
- Nov 2010: Faces charges of crimes against humanity and war crimes allegedly committed in Central African Republic in 2002-03
