
Talks resume on Iranian nuclear ambitions

After more than a year of deadlock, Iran and six world powers are meeting in Geneva for two days of talks over Tehran's contentious nuclear programme, which the West fears is geared toward enriching uranium for weapons rather than fuel for its civilian reactors



Iran claimed on eve of talks to have produced its first batch of "yellowcake" – raw material for enrichment – making it self-sufficient in uranium production
