

Korea's new armed robot

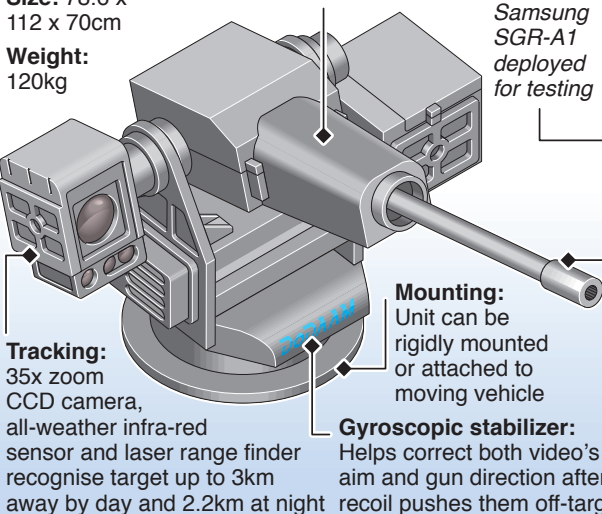
Following a six-month trial of automated sentries along the southern boundary of Korea's Demilitarized Zone, Seoul-based defence manufacturer DoDaam Systems has developed an even more advanced robotic gun tower – the Super Aegis 2 – to counter incursions through the DMZ

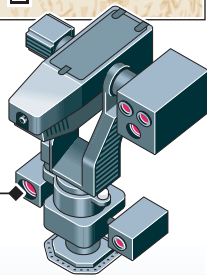
