U.S. suspicious of Myanmar nuke programme

The United States has suspected for years that Myanmar has a secret nuclear programme aided by North Korea, according to diplomatic cables released by whistle-blower website WikiLeaks



- ▶ Jan 2004: Cable says foreign businessman told U.S. embassy in Yangon of rumours, circulating since 2002, that nuclear reactor was being built near town of *Minbu*
- ▶ Aug 2004: Another cable says informant saw North Korean workers building surface-to-air missiles and underground facility near Minbu
- ▶ Jul 2009: U.S. Secretary of State Hillary Clinton warns of possible nuclear links between Myanmar and North Korea
- ▶ Jun 2010: Report by Norwaybased *Democratic Voice of Burma* says Mynamar is trying to develop nuclear weapons, giving evidence of underground bunkers and tunnels allegedly built with North Korean help
- ▶ Jul 2010: Clinton says ship from North Korea recently delivered military equipment to Myanmar
- Nov 2010: UN report alleges North Korea is supplying banned nuclear and ballistic equipment to Myanmar as well as Iran and Syria
