
Thousands rally against government in Yemen

Tens of thousands of Yemenis are calling for an end to the government of President Ali Abdullah Saleh, in demonstrations across the capital inspired by the recent popular revolt in Tunisia



Government is riddled with corruption and has little control outside capital. Its main source of income - oil - could run dry in a decade

Proposals to abolish presidential term limits

could allow Saleh to stay in office for life

from 1978 until it merged with South Yemen in 1990. when he became president of unified country
