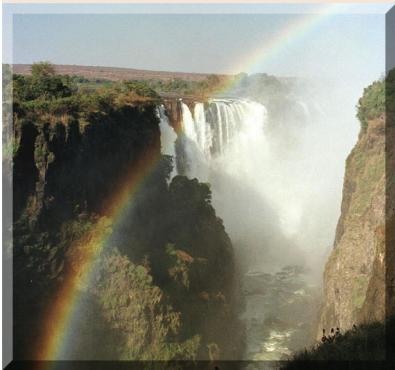

▲ **1855: British explorer David Livingstone discovered the Victoria Falls on Africa's Zambesi River**

1532: Spanish conquistador Francisco Pizzaro seized the Incan emperor Atahualpa

1933: The U.S. and the Soviet Union established diplomatic relations

1988: Benazir Bhutto was elected as Pakistan's first woman prime minister

2009: Australian premier Kevin Rudd apologised to generations of children raised in orphanages and foster homes in the 20th century, including child migrants separated from their parents and siblings
