1787: Delaware voted to adopt the newly created federal constitution, thus becoming the first of the United States

1941: The U.S. entered World War II after Japanese planes attacked the Pacific fleet at Pearl Harbour

1988: Armenia was devastated by an earthquake which wiped out the town of Spitak, killing over 25,000 people

2009: The UN Climate Change Conference opened in Copenhagen, Denmark, aiming to secure a new global agreement to replace the Kyoto Protocol
