▲ **2005: Influential American playwright Arthur Miller, whose works included *Death of a Salesman* and *The Crucible*, died at age 89**

**1763: France ceded Canada to Britain in the Treaty of Paris**

**1898: German playwright Bertold Brecht, whose plays include *The Threepenny Opera* and *Mother Courage*, was born**

**1931: The city of New Delhi became the capital of India**

**1992: The U.S. began a three-week airlift of food and medical aid to the former Soviet republics, struggling to establish democracy**
