 1991: Plays key role in first *Gulf War*, leading Egypt's forces in

coalition that liberates Kuwait following Iraqi invasion. Appointed Defence Minister

1995: Becomes commander-inchief of Egyptian Armed Forces

■ 2008: Leaked U.S. diplomatic cable describes Tantawi as "aged and change-resistant"

■ Feb 2011: Wins praise for allowing massive protests to unfold, forcing President *Hosni Mubarak* from power
