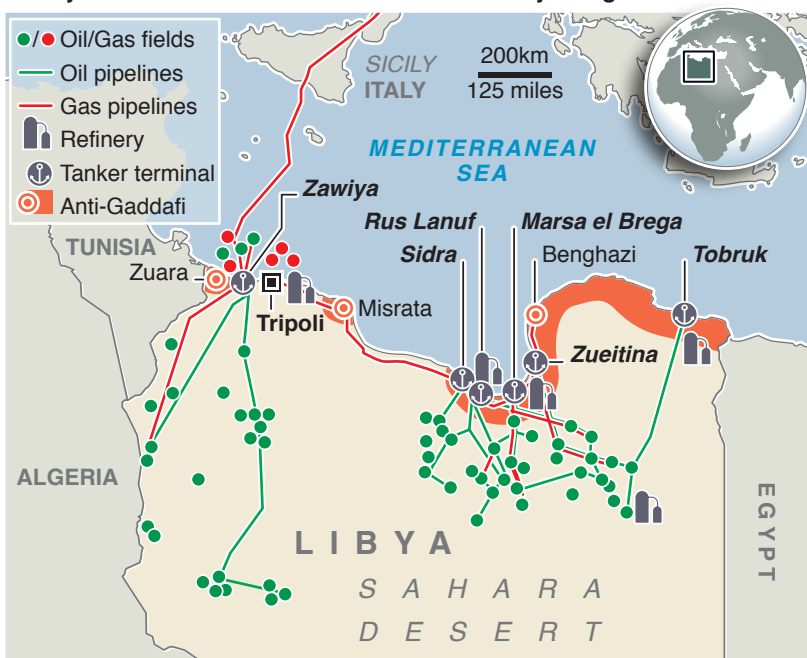


Libya's oil output cut by up to 75%

Turmoil in Libya has seen oil output slashed by 75% or 1.2 million barrels per day. Libya exported 1.5 million barrels of crude a day in January, mostly from eastern terminals – now controlled by anti-government forces
