Japan's biggest carmakers have extended their shutdown to cope with earthquake-damaged factories and power blackouts. In January, Japan produced 706,107 automobiles and exported 365,000 (52%) of them

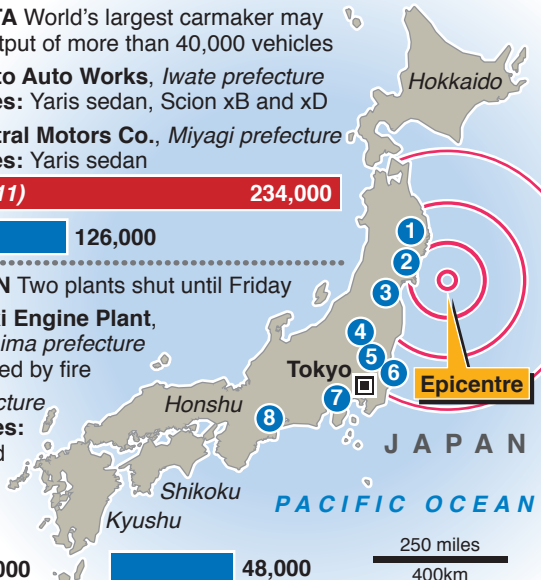
