



U.S.: Helicopter carrier *USS Kearsage*, two missile destroyers, and *USS Providence* missile submarine in Mediterranean Sea. Aircraft carrier *USS Enterprise* en route to Red Sea. AWACS aircraft and two U.S. KC-130J tankers deployed to Sicily, four C-130J Hercules transports to Crete



UK: Tornado and Typhoon fighter bombers, AWACS, and VC-10 tankers deployed to RAF Akrotiri, Cyprus. Royal Navy frigate *HMS Cumberland*, plus support ships, in Mediterranean

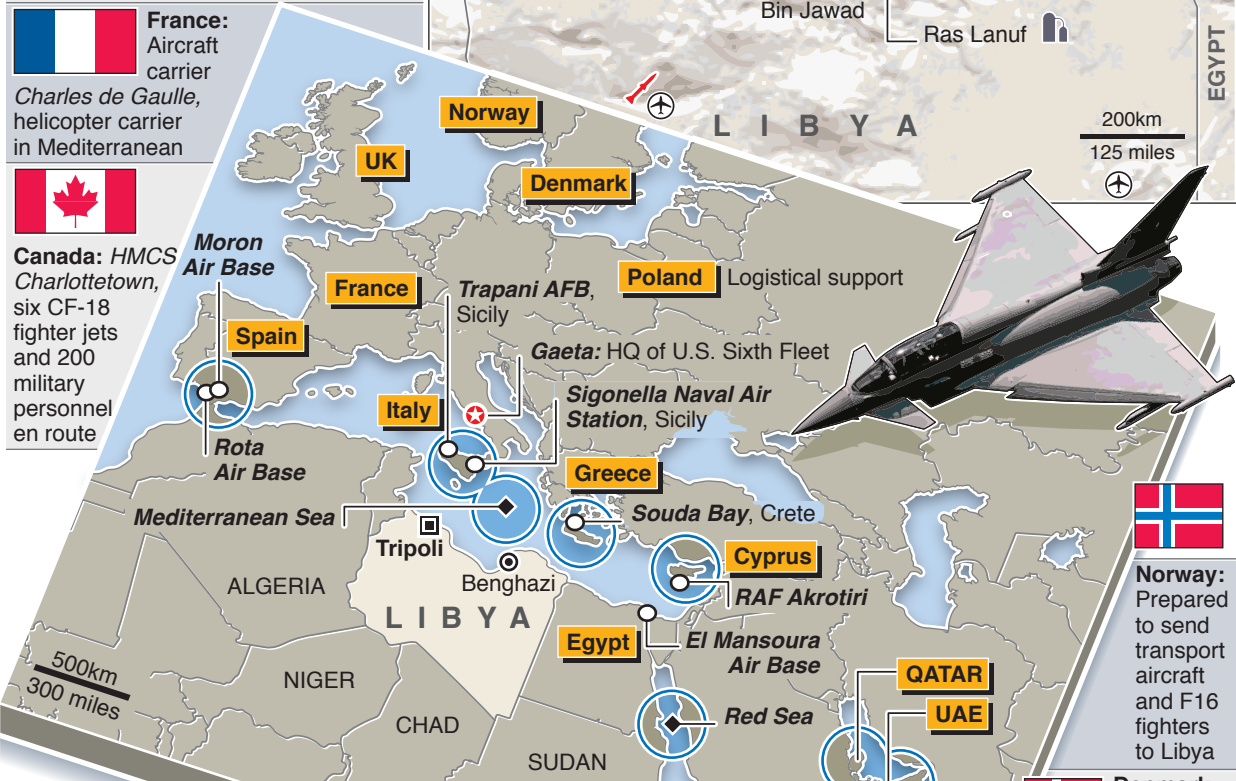
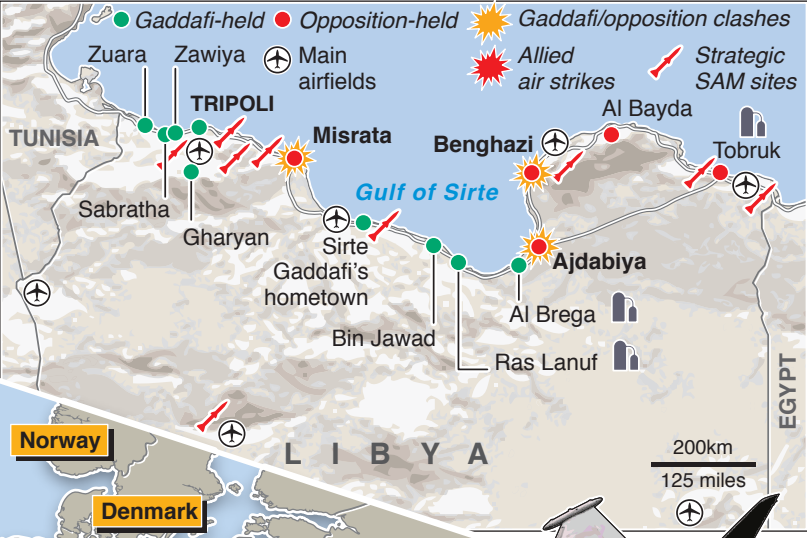


France: Aircraft carrier *Charles de Gaulle*, helicopter carrier in Mediterranean



Canada: *HMCS Charlottetown*, six CF-18 fighter jets and 200 military personnel en route

Norway: Prepared to send transport aircraft and F16 fighters to Libya



Denmark: To deploy four F-16s



Spain: Offered use of two military bases. One of its four submarines, *Mistral S-73* – armed with Exocet anti-ship missiles – currently deployed in Mediterranean
