Queen from 1420-22

Wife of Henry V. Died in 1437 – her corpse later became macabre tourist attraction after her coffin was accidentally opened during reign of Henry VII

Catherine of Aragon 1509-33 First wife of Henry VIII.

He divorced her after 24 years of marriage failed to produce a male heir, leading England to split with Catholic Church







Catherine Howard

1540-41 Believed to be only about 16 years old when she became Henry VIII's fifth wife - over 30 years

his junior. Beheaded for

adultery in 1542

1543-47 Last of Henry VIII's six wives. She is England's most-married Queen. with four husbands - two before Henry and one after his death in 1547
