2009 Angel Cabrera ARG 276 (-12) AFTER PLAY-OFF

Cabrera Celebrates Cabrera defeats Perry and Campbell in a 3-way sudden death play-off to clinch 2nd Major title, and becomes first Argentine to win the Masters



2002 Tiger Woods USA 276 (-12)

Back-to-back Titles Woods successfully defends title - winning by 3 shots first champion to do so since Nick Faldo in 1990. Only 3rd Masters double in history



2006 Phil Mickelson USA 281 (-7)

Second Green Jacket Mickelson wins 2nd Masters. leading from third round, hits final round 69 to win by two shots - a 2nd consecutive Major after 2005 USPGA



2010 Phil Mickelson USA 272 (-16)

Phil's Hat-trick Mickelson hits a bogey-free round of 67 to claim third Masters victory, eventually winning by 3 shots over England's Lee Westwood



2003 Mike Weir CAN 281 (-7) AFTER PLAY-OFF

First Canadian Major Weir recovers from poor 3rd round to clinch title with first hole play-off victory over Len Mattiace - becomes first lefthanded Masters champion



2007 Zach Johnson USA 289(+1)

Zach's Fairvtale Finish Johnson hits 3 birdies on final six holes, holding off Woods and Goosen, to seal first Major - first player ranked outside top 50 to win Masters



Phil Mickelson USA 279 (-9) Fantastic First

Mickelson ends long wait for first Major title – paired with Els. he defeats the South African by one shot with an 18ft birdie on the final hole



2008 Trevor Immelman RSA 280 (-8)

🔒 Maiden Major Immelman holds nerve and leads from start to finish becomes first wire-to-wire Masters champion since Raymond Floyd in 1976
