- in Damascus and Hama. At least 23 reportedly killed around Syria
- Mar 26: Twelve killed in protests in Latakia. Assad deploys army
- Mar 29: Government resigns. Thousands of Syrians hold progovernment rallies
- Mar 30: Assad blames foreign conspirators for unrest but declines to elaborate on major reform
