Laos delays decision to build Mekong dam

Laos has deferred a decision to build the Xayaburi dam on the lower Mekong River in face of opposition from neighbouring countries including its closest ally, Vietnam

▶ Opponents fear \$3.5 billion project would open door to building spree of up to 10 other dams on lower Mekong, degrading river's fragile ecology

Laos says revenue from 1,260MW

dam will spur economic and social development. Thailand has already agreed to buy 95% of electricity output

▶ Dam would forcibly resettle 2,100 people and could affect livelihoods of millions of others

Mekong is second only to Amazon in terms of biodiversity, with more than 1,000 fish species, including critically endangered Mekong giant catfish

► Government ministers from Laos, Cambodia, Thailand and Vietnam will meet to consider issue later this year
