Timeline of the world's most wanted man



- Mar 1957: Osama bin Muhammad bin Awad bin Laden born in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. Seventh son among 50 or more siblings
- 1968: Bin Laden's father dies in plane crash. Osama inherits millions
- 1979-89: Bin Laden builds reputation helping U.S.-sponsored mujahideen fight Soviet troops during

invasion of Afghanistan, Founds

Al Qaeda - "the base" - to focus on holy wars abroad

- Feb 1993: Bomb attack at World Trade Centre in New York kills six people. Bomber linked to Al Qaeda
- 1996: Bin Laden sets up terrorist training camps in Afghanistan under protection of Taliban
- 1997: CIA begins to prepare plan to capture bin Laden
- Aug 7, 1998: Bombings of U.S. embassies in Kenya and Tanzania kill 231 people
- Oct 12, 2000: Attack on destroyer USS Cole in Yemen kills 17 sailors
- Sep 11, 2001: Attacks on World Trade Centre in New York and Pentagon in Washington, plus aircrash
- in Pennsylvania, kill almost 3,000 2002: Al Qaeda-linked attacks take place in Tunisia, Kenya, Saudi Arabia, Morocco, Indonesia and Turkey, killing more than 360 people

- Mar 11, 2004: Bombs on commuter trains in Madrid kill 191 people
- **Jul 7, 2005:** 52 people killed by suicide bombers in London
- Jul-Nov: Bomb attacks in Egypt. Bali and Jordan leave 170 dead
- Jun 2, 2008: Al Qaeda bombs Danish embassy in Pakistan
- attack on Northwest Airlines Flight 253 admits he was trained by Al Qaeda in Yemen, U.S. President Barack Obama later declares on TV "We are at war against Al Qaeda"

Dec 25, 2009: Perpetrator of failed

- Aug 2010: CIA tracks Al Qaeda courier to fortified compound in Pakistani town of Abbottabad. Multiple intelligence reports suggests that bin Laden is planning to "pursue an aggressive course of action"
- Oct 29: Two bombs found on cargo planes bound from Yemen to U.S. Al Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula claims responsibility for plot
- Feb-Apr 2011: President Obama leads five meetings of National Security Council focused solely on whether bin Laden is in Abbottabad compound
- May 1 2011: Contingent of U.S. Navy's SEAL Team Six is tasked with attacking compound. Bin Laden is killed during 40-minute firefight
