Demjanjuk guilty



- 1920: Born in Ukraine
- 1952: Enters U.S. claiming he spent most of war as German prisoner
- 1977: Identified by survivors of Treblinka concentration camp
- as guard "Ivan The Terrible"

 1981: Stripped of U.S. citizenship
- 1986-88: Extradited to Israel, tried and sentenced to death but conviction later overturned on
- 2002: Loses U.S. citizenship for second time after judge says there is proof he worked at Nazi camps

grounds of mistaken identity

- 2009: Deported by U.S. to stand trial in Munich formally charged with 27,900 counts of accessory to murder at Sobibor camp in Poland
- May 12, 2011: John Demjanjuk found guilty and sentenced to five years in prison
