 Dominique Strauss-Kahn:
 62-year-old IMF chief and French presidential hopeful

Friday afternoon: During private visit to New York, Strauss-Kahn checks into Sofitel hotel in Manhattan, paying discounted rate of \$800 for luxury suite



Saturday, between 12:00-13:00:
Chambermaid enters room 2806,
Strauss-Kahn's suite. Sexual assault
allegedly takes place.
32-year-old African woman
reports incident to supervisor
who calls police



12:28: Strauss-Kahn checks out of hotel but leaves mobile phone behind

13:30: Police arrive at hotel

About 15:30: Strauss-Kahn calls hotel security to report missing phone, tells staff member he is at New York's JFK Airport

16:00: Strauss-Kahn boards Air France flight 23 for Paris

About 16:30: Port Authority police board aircraft and detain Strauss-Kahn

16:33: *New York Post* breaks story of detention on its website



Strauss-Kahn hauled off Air France flight

Sunday 11:00: Strauss-Kahn taken to Kings County Hospital in Brooklyn where he is examined by forensic technicians

Monday 12:00: Arraignment at Manhattan Criminal Court – defendant denied bail. Strauss-Kahn to be held at New York's Rikers Island prison



16:59: First tweets appear on *Twitter*, triggering global media frenzy

Sunday. 02:15: Strauss-Kahn formally arrested

16:30: In identity parade, chambermaid identifies Strauss-Kahn as her assailant

Monday: Defence attorney *Benjamin Brafman* (above left) says his client is innocent and was having lunch with his daughter Camille – PhD student at Columbia University

Thursday: Dominique Strauss-Kahn resigns from post as head of IMF and denies all criminal charges
