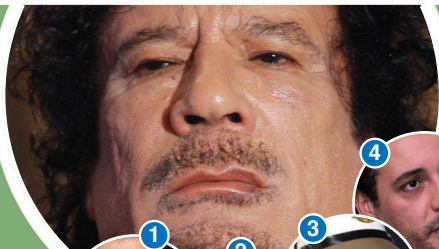


Pressure mounting on Gaddafi's inner circle

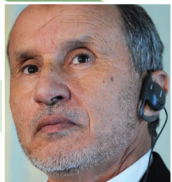
Gaddafi appears to retain backing of sons **Mutassim**, National Security Adviser (1), **Saadi**, Commander of special forces (2), **Khamis**, Commander of 32nd Brigade (3), and **Hannibal**, who holds senior role at National Maritime Transport Company (4). Second youngest son, **Saif al-Arab** (5), killed by Nato air strike on May 1

MOST PROMINENT DEFECTORS

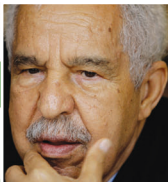


Shukri Ghanem
Oil minister and head of state-run National Oil Corp. – thought to have defected May 16

Moussa Koussa
Foreign minister and former head of Libyan intelligence – defected to Britain Mar 30



Mustafa Abdul Jalil
Former justice minister defected Feb 21 – named chairman of rebels' provisional government



Ali Abdussalam el-Treki
Former foreign minister and president of UN General Assembly – fled to Egypt Mar 31



Major General Abdul-Fattah Younis
Former interior minister and special forces chief – defected to rebels Feb 22
