
## **Threat from Libya's ageing MANPADS**

British and French attack helicopters deployed to Libya are vulnerable to tens of thousands of Soviet-era SA-7 man-portable air defence systems -

MANPADS - that were delivered to Muammar Gaddafi's forces in the 1970s Strela shoulder-launched missile (SA-7) Maximum range: 5.500m



## 9M32M surface-to-air missile



140cm

- 1. Operator activates power supply and waits for missile's avroscopes to stabilize
- 2. Target tracked with iron sights, operator pulls trigger - this activates infrared seeker
- 3. Missile alerts operator that target is locked on by illuminating red light in sight and producing
- buzzing noise
- 4. Operator has 0.8 seconds to provide lead to target before rocket motor ignites
- 5. Missile homes in on heat from aircraft's engines
