▲ **1930: Ras Tafari was proclaimed Emperor Haile Selassie of Ethiopia**

**1898:** Henry Luce, American publisher of Time, Fortune, and Life magazines, was born in Tengchow, China

**1933: The first flights over Mount Everest in the Himalayas were made by four Britons in two Westland biplanes**

**1949:** Transjordan signed an armistice with the newly founded state of Israel

**2010: Eugene Terreblanche, founder of South Africa's Afrikaner Resistance Movement, was hacked to death by two workers on his farm after a dispute over unpaid wages**
