▲ **2010:** Following a state funeral Polish President Lech Kaczynski and his wife Maria were buried at the historic Wawel Cathedral in Krakow

**1934:** The world's first ever launderette, the "Washateria", was opened in Fort Worth, Texas

**1954:** Gamal Abdel Nasser became prime minister of Egypt

**1982:** Salisbury, the capital of Zimbabwe, was renamed Harare

**2010:** George Washington, the first U.S. President, was found to owe \$300,000 for overdue library books borrowed five months into his presidency, which he failed to return
