▲ **2010:** Britain's new prime minister, Conservative Party leader David Cameron, and his deputy, Liberal Democrat Nick Clegg, outlined the terms of their coalition agreement

**1926:** Jozef Pilsudski led a successful military coup in Poland

**1969:** The minimum voting age in Britain was lowered from 21 to 18

**1994:** A token force of Palestinian police entered the West Bank after 27 years of Israeli military rule

**2010:** An Afriqiyah Airways flight from South Africa crashed in Tripoli, Libya; a 10-year-old child was the sole survivor of 103 people on board
