▲ **1846:** Settlers proclaimed the free republic of California, declaring independence from Mexico in the Bear Flag Revolt

**1839:** The first Henley Regatta took place on the River Thames in London

**1928:** Cuban guerrilla leader Ernesto “Che” Guevara was born in Argentina

**1982:** Argentine forces surrendered at Port Stanley, ending the Falklands War

**2009:** Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu responded to pressure from Washington by finally giving his conditional endorsement to the establishment of a Palestinian state
