Accelerometer acts as tilt sensor

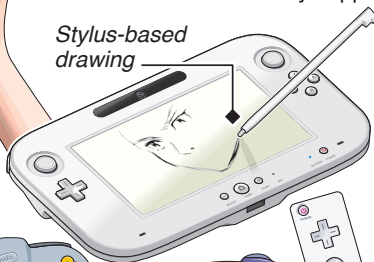


6.2-inch touchscreen resembles tablet PC
