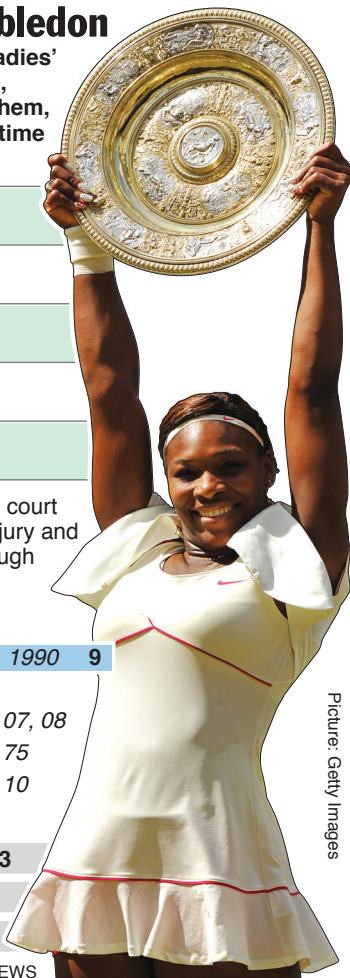
Serena Williams returns to grass court action after a turbulent year of injury and illness. Will she be match-fit enough to seal three in a row at SW19?
