

Lamborghini's new raging bull

The Aventador – a €255,000 supercar that accelerates from 0-100km/h in 2.9 seconds and goes on to reach 350km/h – is the long awaited replacement for Lamborghini's legendary Murciélago

Structure: World's first carbon-fibre monocoque production car is 30% lighter and 150% stiffer than steel frame of Murciélago

Aluminium scissor-doors

Engine: V12, 6.5 litre produces 515kW at 8,250rpm

Haldex all-wheel-drive



Suspension: F1-style pushrod

Wheelbase: 2,700mm

Brakes: 400mm carbon ceramic discs

Aircraft-style LCD instrument display

Second screen displays multimedia and navigation system



Transmission: Paddle shift, 7-speed AMT gives fastest gear change of any road car – just 50 milliseconds

Strada, Sport, Corsa: Three driving modes adjust engine, transmission, steering and dynamic control

Engine start: Button under metallic red flap
