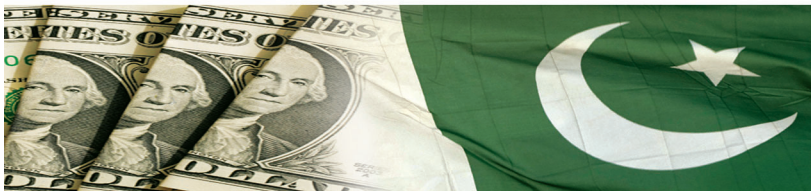


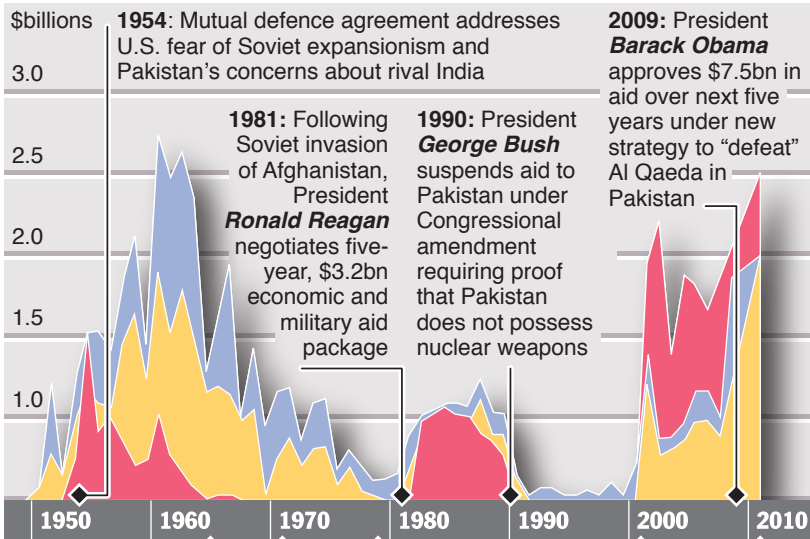
Timeline of U.S. assistance to Pakistan

1965, 1971: India-Pakistan wars prompt temporary suspensions of military aid to both sides, leading to cooling of U.S.-Pakistani ties

1979: President **Jimmy Carter** cuts off military assistance over Pakistan's covert construction of uranium enrichment facility

2001: **General Musharraf** becomes key ally of President **George W. Bush** after 9/11 – U.S. provides nearly \$12bn in aid from 2002-08

Jun 2011: U.S. withholds \$800m in military aid following weeks of tension after Islamabad is not warned of raid that killed **Osama bin Laden**
