May 2: U.S. commandos stage covert raid that kills Osama bin I aden in garrison town of Abbottabad.

leading to suspicion that Pakistani security agents knew where Al Qaeda chief was hiding

May 14: Pakistan parliament condemns raid, calling for review of U.S. ties and warning that Pakistan could cut supply lines to U.S. forces in Afghanistan if there are more such attacks

Jun 9: CIA head Leon Panetta - now Secretary of Defence – visits Pakistan to urge continuation of critical intelligence operations

Jul 8: Top U.S. military chief Adm. Mike Mullen claims Islamabad sanctioned killing of journalist who had published articles linking Pakistan military to Al Qaeda - Islamabad rejects accusation
