

Goran Hadzic

Serbia has confirmed the arrest of Goran Hadzic, the last remaining Yugoslav war crimes suspect sought by the International Criminal Tribunal in The Hague



■ **52-year-old Hadzic** was former leader of Croatia's rebel Serbs during country's bloody ethnic war

■ **Wanted for atrocities** stemming from 1991-1995 conflict, when he fought against Croatian independence from former Yugoslavia

■ **Went into hiding** in July 2004 after UN tribunal issued indictment against him. \$1.4 million bounty offered for his capture

■ **Faces 14 counts** of war crimes, including murder of over 250 Croat civilians in Vukovar in 1991, and deportation of 20,000 non-Serbs

■ **Arrest** comes less than two months after capture of former Bosnian Serb general **Ratko Mladic**, and removes last barrier to Serbia's EU candidacy
