52-year-old Hadzic was former leader of Croatia's rebel Serbs during country's bloody ethnic war

Wanted for atrocities stemming

- Wanted for atrocities stemming from 1991-1995 conflict, when he fought against Croatian independence from former Yugoslavia
- Went into hiding in July 2004 after UN tribunal issued indictment against him. \$1.4 million bounty offered for his capture
- Faces 14 counts of war crimes, including murder of over 250 Croat civilians in Vukovar in 1991, and deportation of 20,000 non-Serbs
- Arrest comes less than two months after capture of former Bosnian Serb general Ratko Mladic, and removes last barrier to Serbia's EU candidacy
