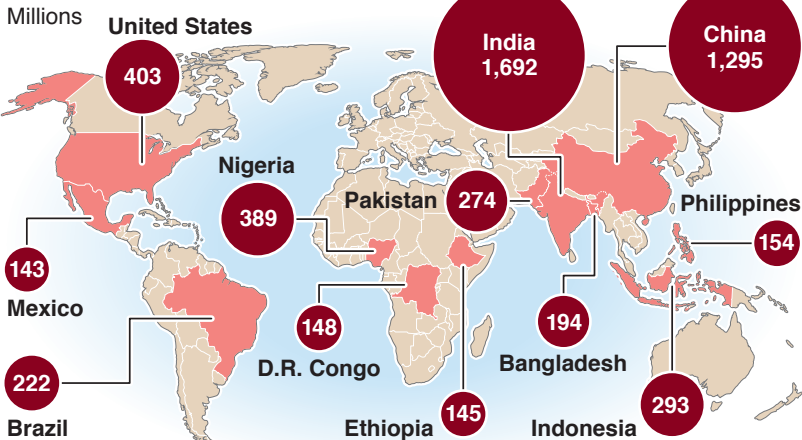


Global population seven billion and counting

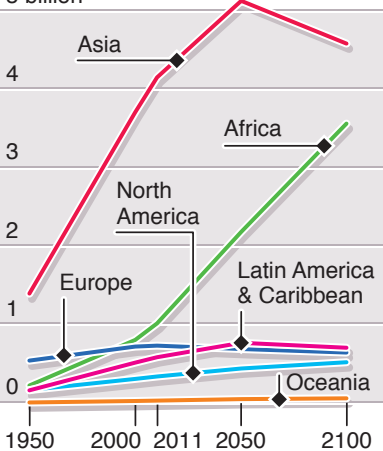

POPULATION GROWTH BY REGION

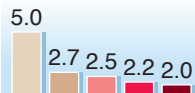

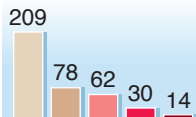

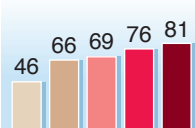
Fertility rate
Children born per woman



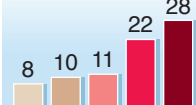
Under-5 mortality
