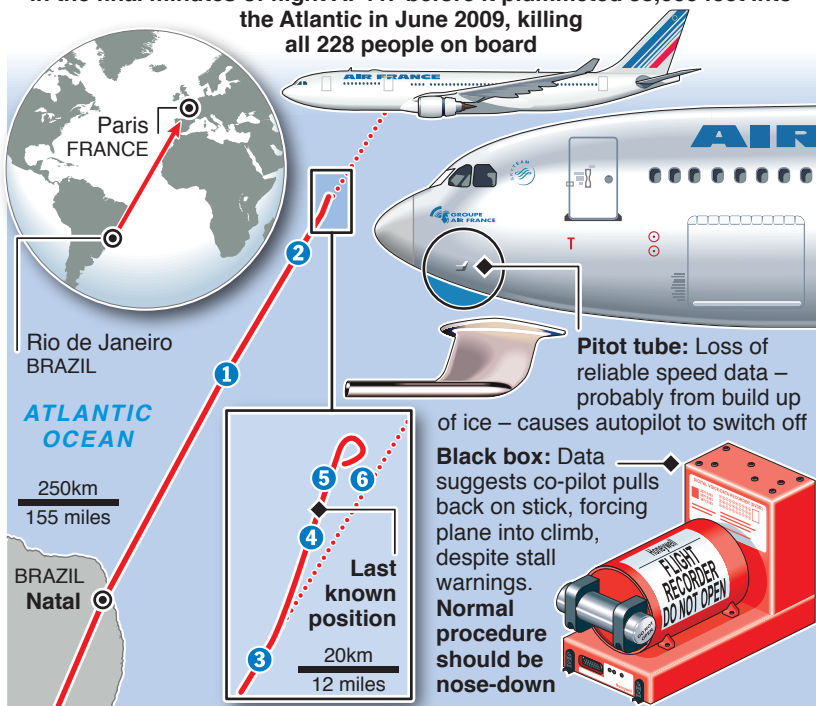


Air France 447 – “pilots ignored warnings”

French investigators report that pilots failed to discuss “stall” alarms in the final minutes of flight AF447 before it plummeted 38,000 feet into the Atlantic in June 2009, killing all 228 people on board



1 01:35GMT: Crew informs controller of location

2 01:59-02:06: Pilot flying (PF) warns of turbulence ahead. Captain leaves cockpit for routine rest

3 02:08: Turbulence increases slightly, PF turns about 12 degrees to left of route. Reduces speed from around 1,000km/h

4 02:10: Black box shows speed falling sharply to 111km/h. Auto-pilot and auto-thrust disengage – stall warning sounds twice

5 02:11-02:13: Captain re-enters cockpit. Instruments indicate rise in speed to 398km/h, but stall warning sounds again

6 02:14: Recordings stop
