

# Mubarak on trial

The accused include former Egyptian President Hosni Mubarak, 83, his two sons, former interior minister Habib al-Adli, six senior police officers – including four of Adli's deputies – and prominent businessman Hussein Salem, a close confidant of Mubarak



## MUBARAK CHARGES

- ▶ Conspiring with Adli and police officers over brutal suppression of uprising in which around 850 people were killed and over 6,000 wounded
- ▶ Squandering public money in natural gas deal with Israel. Salem, also charged, alleged to have siphoned \$714 million out of deal
- ▶ Allowing Salem to acquire large tracts of state land in tourist region of South Sinai
- ▶ Using position to secure wealth and privileges for himself and his sons, including property valued at \$6.7 million

**If convicted, he could face death penalty**



### Mubarak's sons

**Gamal** – once seen as being groomed for presidency – and **Alaa** both held senior posts in ruling party. Charged with crimes committed in association with their father

### Habib al-Adli

Hated owing to brutal crushing of all opposition to regime. Already sentenced to 12 years in jail for profiteering and money-laundering

### Hussein Salem

Former intelligence chief, arrested on international warrant, currently hospitalised in Spain
