

- 1980, St Pauls, Bristol
  Police drugs raid on cafe leads to
  disturbances. Over 130 arrests
- 2 1981, Brixton, South London
  Death of black man blamed on police
  brutality. Damage in subsequent
  rioting put at £7.5m. Further riots
  in Brixton in 1985, 1995 and 2001
- 1981, Toxteth, Liverpool
  Allegations of police discrimination
  against black community spark nine
  days of violence. Up to 1,000 police
  injured, 140 buildings destroyed
- 1985, Tottenham, London
  Violence erupts on Broadwater Farm
  estate after woman suffers heart
  failure during police raid on her home.
  Police officer stabbed to death

- Central London rally against deeply unpopular tax leads to worst rioting in decades. Over 100 people injured

  6 2001, Oldham: Tensions between
- white majority and ethnic minority communities flare up in series of riots across north of England
- 2010, Student riots, London Peaceful protests against plans to raise tuition fees turn violent when small group attacks Conservative Party HQ. Car carrying *Prince of Wales* and wife *Camilla* attacked
- Aug 2011: Looting and arson attacks in much of London and other cities after police shoot man in Tottenham
