

Chinese bullet train maker orders recall

A Chinese bullet train manufacturer has announced a recall of more than 50 trains in the wake of a July crash that killed 40 people. The recall could prompt Beijing to scale back its rapid expansion of the high-speed rail network, which is projected to have 25,000km of track by 2020
