Anna Hazare profile



- 1937: Born in village of Ralegan Siddhi, in Indian state of Maharashtra
- 1975-1980s: After army service, returns to native village, lifting it out of grinding poverty so successfully that state government replicates model across Maharashtra
- 1991: Launches first campaign against corruption
- 1997: Uses hunger strike to push Maharashtra government to enact Right to Information law precursor
- to national law enacted in 2005

 2003: Forces Congress-NCP state government to set up investigation against four ministers
- Apr 2011: Ends three-day fast after Delhi agrees to introduce bill creating ombudsman with powers to investigate and punish corrupt officials
- Aug 16: Detained hours before beginning indefinite hunger strike in protest against proposed legislation he condemns as toothless. Up to 1,300 supporters also arrested
