
■ Mustafa Mohammed Abdul Jalil ► Head of National Transitional Council

Former development official under Gaddafi, has built up extensive experience and contacts in his role as NTC's foreign affairs representative



U.S.-based academic and opposition figure in exile. Returned to Libya to take charge of economic, financial and oil affairs for rebel council

Ghoga. Spokesman,
NTC vice-chairman

Libyan human rights lawyer and community organiser. Has said NTC could move to Tripoli following fall of Gaddafi regime

Shokri Ghanem

Served as Gaddafi's prime minister and top oil official from 2003. Credited with liberalizing Libyan economy. Defected from regime in May 2011 to join rebels
