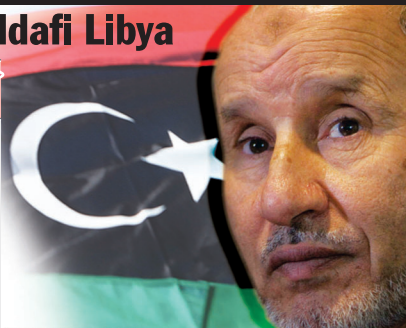


Key figures in post-Gaddafi Libya

■ **Mustafa Mohammed Abdul Jalil** *Head of National Transitional Council*

Served as justice minister under Gaddafi, resigned at start of uprising after violence was used against protesters. Has outlined 20-month transition period to elections, with NTC to continue for first eight months. Says he will resign as NTC chairman if rebel fighters resort to reprisals



■ **Mahmoud Jibril** *NTC prime minister*

Former development official under Gaddafi, has built up extensive experience and contacts in his role as NTC's foreign affairs representative



■ **Abdul Hafiz Ghoga**. *Spokesman, NTC vice-chairman*

Libyan human rights lawyer and community organiser. Has said NTC could move to Tripoli following fall of Gaddafi regime



■ **Ali Tarhouni** *NTC finance minister*

U.S.-based academic and opposition figure in exile. Returned to Libya to take charge of economic, financial and oil affairs for rebel council



■ **Shokri Ghanem**

Served as Gaddafi's prime minister and top oil official from 2003. Credited with liberalizing Libyan economy. Defected from regime in May 2011 to join rebels
