temporary tax increases to help pay for planned \$170 billion reconstruction of tsunami-devastated northeast

- Yen: As Finance Minister, Noda set up \$100 billion credit line to help boost Japanese companies investing overseas and stem rise in value of ven, which hit record high of ¥75.94 to US\$ on August 19
 - Public debt: Supports ruling DPJ's plan to double 5% sales tax by middecade to cut debt - already twice size of Japan's \$5 trillion economy
 - Energy policy: Opposes outgoing Prime Minister Naoto Kan's vision of nuclear power-free society, saving trust in nuclear needs to be restored
- Foreign relations: Stresses importance of U.S.-Japan security alliance as core of Japan's diplomacy. Says China's rapid military buildup poses serious regional risk
