

Gaddafi's whereabouts remain a mystery

Despite the fall of Tripoli to National Transitional Council (NTC) rebel forces, Colonel Muammar Gaddafi has continued to evade capture

Tripoli: Pockets of remaining loyalists could provide hiding place and support

Bani Walid: Pop. 50,000. Stronghold of loyalist Warfalla tribe, recent refuge for Gaddafi sons Saif al-Islam and Khamis – latter allegedly killed Aug 29

Sirte: Pop. 128,000. Gaddafi's birthplace and home to wider Gaddafi tribe

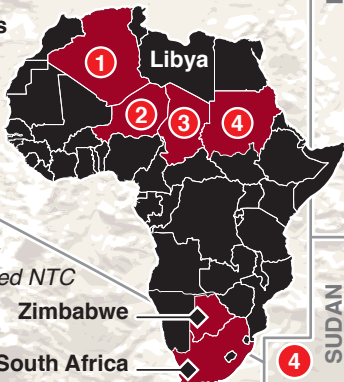
