

# Libyan army convoy arrives in Niger

A large convoy of Libyan army vehicles has crossed into Niger in what could be a secretly negotiated bid by Muammar Gaddafi to seek refuge in a friendly African country, according to reports citing military sources from France and Niger

**1 Agadez:** 200-250 vehicles arrive in desert town on Monday. Not known if any Gaddafi family members are present. Convoy proceeding to Niger capital – close to **Burkina Faso**, which has offered Gaddafi asylum

**2 Bani Walid:** Libyan rebels say convoy left on Saturday, possibly with Gaddafi's son **Saif al-Islam**. Rebels have now reached deal for peaceful handover of town

**3 Sirte:** Gaddafi loyalists given deadline of Sep 10 to surrender

**4 Sebha:** Isolated town heavily garrisoned by loyalists could be possible location of Gaddafi

**5 Djanet:** 32 members of Gaddafi family arrive Aug 29, including wife, two sons and daughter
