Burhanuddin Rabbani



- 1940: Born in Badakhshan province ethnic Tajik by birth
- 1972: Founds party that becomes Afghan mujahideen that fights Soviet occupation in 1980s
- 1992: Becomes President after fall of Soviet-backed regime
- 1996: Ousted by Taliban becomes nominal head of anti-Taliban Northern Alliance, made up of mostly non-Pashtun ethnic groups
- 2001: Taliban toppled by Northern Alliance backed by U.S. forces Rabbani, still recognised as head of state by UN, hands power to interim government of *Hamid Karzai*
- Sep 20, 2011: Rabbani, chosen by Karzai to head Peace Council tasked with negotiating with Taliban, killed in suspected suicide attack at his home in Kabul
