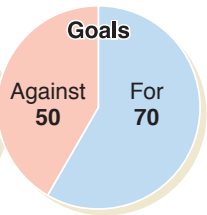
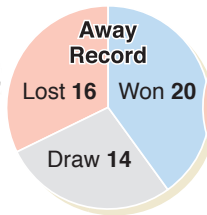
CHAMPIONS LEAGUE
