

iPhone 4's voice-powered "assistant"


Apple's iPhone 4S, with faster chips and better cameras, debuts Siri – voice-recognition technology which allows a user to converse with the device. iPhone 4S will be released in seven countries on October 14

8-megapixel camera: 30% sharper, with aperture of f/2.4. Autofocus with LED flash. Capable of HD video at 30 frames/sec

Processor: Dual-core, A5 doubles performance and boosts graphics by up to seven times.

 New iOS 5 operating system includes **iMessage** messaging system and **Newsstand** app

 **Siri:** Allows user to control functions and apps through voice commands, can even answer questions. Initially supports English, French and German

 **iCloud:** Apple's free service stores content and syncs it across iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, Macs, PCs
