Aug 1/9: Arbabsiar,

but is denied entry and placed on return flight to New York

Sep 29: Arrested at JFK airport during flight layover

Oct 4-5: Arbabsiar, in custody since arrest, agrees to make monitored phone calls to Shakuri in Iran. Shakuri said to be member of Quds Force -Iran's Revolutionary Guard Corps

Shakuri tells Arbabsiar plot should move forward as quickly as possible, stating "just do it quickly, it's late"
