- Education: Philosophy degree from university of Damascus. Spends a year at Sorbonne, Paris
- Socialist Party at university later adopts more religious viewpoint

■ Politics: Joins European

- 1981, Apr: Establishes *Ennahda* (Renaissance) party
- Jul: Sentenced to 11 years in jail. Released in 1984
- 1987: Rearrested and sentenced to life imprisonment. Released 1988.
