Hidden consequences of Palestine UN bid

For Palestinians, joining UNESCO is the first step towards international recognition – but the move also has implications for the rest of the world. A 1994 U.S. law means the country must withdraw from any international organisation which accepts Palestine as a full member state


World Intellectual Property Organisation: Sets global copyright and patent standards, adjudicates disputes - vital for WIPO U.S. economic interests
