
Carlos the Jackal on trial in France

Carlos the Jackal, one of the most dreaded terror masterminds of the Cold War, is on trial again – this time over four deadly attacks in France nearly three decades ago

Carlos the Jackal – real name **Ilich Ramirez Sanchez** – pictured in 1979 and 2000



▶ Early life: Studied in Moscow before joining *Popular Front for Liberation of Palestine* in 1970. Given code name "Carlos" by PFLP. Converted to Islam in 1975

▶ Dec 1975: Achieved notoriety for raid on OPEC headquarters in Vienna, which killed three people

▶ 1970s and 80s: Linked to attacks on several Western targets. Dubbed "The Jackal" by press after assassin in thriller novel *Day of the Jackal* 

▶ 1994: Arrested in Sudan and flown to Paris. Convicted in 1997 and sentenced to life in prison for murder of two French secret agents and alleged informer in 1975
